Robert F. Kennedy Jr., Environmental Lawyer, Author, and Activist to speak at KU

Lawrence, KS --- Student Union Activities, Student Senate, and the Lied Center are hosting Robert F. Kennedy Jr. as this year's Student Lecture Series speaker. Mr. Kennedy will speak on the topic of "Crimes Against Nature" on Wednesday, April 11, 2007 at the Lied Center at 8 PM. Following the lecture Oread Bookstore will host a book sale and signing of Mr. Kennedy's three *New York Times* bestselling books.

Mr. Kennedy is a senior attorney for the Natural Resources Defense Council, chief prosecuting attorney for the Hudson Riverkeeper and president of Waterkeeper Alliance. He is also a clinical professor and supervising attorney at Pace University School of Law's Environmental Litigation Clinic and co-host of *Ring of Fire* on Air America Radio. He was named one of *Time* magazine's "Heroes for the Planet" for his success in helping Riverkeeper lead the fight to restore the Hudson River.
