Student Union Activities to host second annual Carnival for KU students and faculty

Following the success of last year’s SUA Carnival, this event will showcase more rides, games and activities for the KU community.

The Carnival will feature five rides: the Ferris wheel, sizzler and roll-a-plane from last year’s Carnival and the blast and musical chairs, two new rides. The Carnival will include seventeen game and activity booths with prizes, including Ring Pop Toss, Cupcake Walk, Speedball Game, A Photo Booth, Airbrush tattoos, and High Striker. There will also be a food pavilion serving an assortment of fare.
