Spencer Lott Puppet Shows for Children at Oread Books

March 24, 2009 (LAWRENCE, Kan.) - KU student Spencer Lott, creator of Squiggle Puppet Productions, will present puppet shows for children on two Saturdays this Spring at Oread Books on level two of the Kansas Union at the University of Kansas in Lawrence. The events are suitable for children of all ages and are free and open to the public:

Spencer Lott is a graduate of Lawrence Free State High School and is pursuing a degree in Theater and Film at the University of Kansas. In 2006 he was one of 50 participants from the U.S. and Canada to travel to New York for a puppeteer training workshop lead by Sesame Street "muppeteers." He is the designer behind KU's 2008 production of "The King Stag" and is currently working with the KU Opera department on several original works. As Squiggle Puppet Productions, Lott has been building puppets, performing, and teaching with puppets since 2003 in a wide variety of presentations for schools, libraries, and other venues.
