Contestants must be currently enrolled at KU and must work alone, not in pairs or groups.

Six participants will be chosen for the fashion show and final judging for the three additional challenges on Nov. 10 at 7 p.m. in the Kansas Union Ballroom. This year’s guest judge is Korto Momolu from season five of Bravo TV’s “Project Runway” show.
